Thank you for your interest in joining the Teen Team at the Ronald McDonald House of Dallas. The purpose of the Teen Team exists to assist the house in meeting its mission of serving families with seriously ill or injured children. Through a variety of volunteer projects and special events, the Teen Team helps to raise awareness of and interest in the Ronald McDonald House of Dallas in the community.

The 2018-2019 Teen Team will serve from September 2018 through July 2019. You are qualified to be on Teen Team if you are an incoming freshmen, sophomore, junior or senior in high school. Accepted Teen Team members **must** be able to attend a Teen Team Orientation meeting **either Saturday**, **September 15th from 2:00 – 3:00 pm or Sunday**, **September 16th from 2:00-3:00 pm**. Teen Team requirements are participation in one Trains at NorthPark shift and four other service activities throughout the year. Service activities include hosting bingo nights, preparing meals and volunteering at the Trains at NorthPark amongst other scheduled family activities. <u>Please take into account your personal and school schedule and the Teen Team requirements before you apply to be a member.</u>

All of the materials in this packet (application, signed parent consent form, and \$50 application fee (fee can also be paid at September Orientation) must be received by the RMHD Volunteer Coordinator by **5:00 July 13, 2018**. Applications received after July 13 will only be considered if the Teen Team is not full and applicants must pay an additional \$25 late fee – total of \$75 application fee, if late. We select participants for the program based on his/her qualifications. Applicants will be notified of their acceptance via e-mail by July 31st.

PURPOSE OF RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE OF DALLAS

Ronald McDonald House of Dallas (RMHD) is keeping families together, inspiring strength, and giving love and support to families whose children are receiving essential medical care.

PURPOSE OF THE TEEN TEAM OF THE RMHD

The purpose of the Teen Team is to assist the House in meeting its mission of serving families with seriously ill or injured children and to provide an opportunity for teens to learn more about the operations of a non-profit organization.

TEEN TEAM DESCRIPTION

Throughout the year, Teen Team members will plan and attend various service events that support the families that stay at RMHD. Events include preparing breakfast, washing cars, hosting activities for children and families, assisting with third-party events and fundraising. Teen Team is a great opportunity to give back to your community while gaining experience in service, leadership and fundraising.

MANDATORY ORIENTATIONS

Accepted members will receive an orientation from the Ronald McDonald House of Dallas. You must attend one of the Teen Team Orientations which will be held **either Saturday, September 15th from 2:00 – 3:00 pm or Sunday, September 16th from 2:00-3:00 pm** at the Ronald McDonald House of Dallas, 4707 Bengal Street, Dallas, Texas 75235.

PROGRAM COMMITMENTS

A one-year commitment with the possibility of continued service throughout high school years

A \$50 Teen Team membership fee (cash or check made out to the Ronald McDonald House of Dallas; checks may be sent with the application or cash/checks can be collected at the Teen Team Orientation.)

Attend four service activities between September 2018 and July 2019

Attend at least one volunteer shift at the Trains at NorthPark; November 19th, 2018 – January 6th, 2019

Attend a mandatory Teen Team Orientation either Saturday, September 15th from 2:00-3:00 or Sunday, September 16th from 2:00-3:00 at the Ronald McDonald House of Dallas

Parental Consent Form

(Required for youth volunteers under 18 years of age)

I HEREBY AGREE to release and hold harmless the Ronald McDonald House of Dallas, the Teen Board of the Ronald McDonald House of Dallas and its agents, employees and representatives from any and all liability of any kind or nature whatsoever in connection with any loss, damage, or expense suffered or incurred by the above-named youth volunteer as a result of an act or failure to act, intentional or unintentional, by (I) any person who is not an agent, employee or representative of the Ronald McDonald House of Dallas or the Teen Team of the Ronald McDonald House of Dallas, or (II) any other youth volunteer.

TEEN TEAM OFFICER JOB DESCRIPTIONS

All Officers MUST remain in good standing - which means they completed all 4 activities and 1 Trains shift in 2017-2018 and MUST be able to attend the August 26th Orientation.

PRESIDENT:

-Set the agenda, attend, and preside over bi-annual officer meetings and make sure they process in an orderly and efficient manner. The president will check in with officers throughout the year.

VICE PRESIDENT-

-Assist the President in overseeing all of their responsibilities. -In the absence of the President and Immediate Past President, perform all the Presidential responsibilities.

SECRETARY:

-Attend all bi-annual officer meetings and keep a record of proceedings. Must send copies of the minutes to board members within a week after each meeting

-Record and track volunteer hours' monthly

-Work with Communications/Marketing Chairperson to send out items to entire membership as needed

TREASURER:

-Assist Volunteer Coordinator in filing reimbursements to RMHD Staff for officers and members -Run a quarterly report of finances for general leadership meetings -Active participant in the Fundraising Committee

MEMBERSHIP CHAIRPERSON:

-Aid the President in planning orientation

-Attend bi-annual meetings

-leading the membership committee

-New volunteer recruitment (work with Communications/Marketing chairperson)

TRAINS CHAIRPERSON: (heavy time commitment between November 11-January 6)

-Communicate Trains shifts dates and reminders to Teen Team

- -Assist Volunteer Coordinator with shift dates and reminders to community volunteers
- -Assist Volunteer Coordinator with keeping calendar up to date

FUNDRAISING CHAIRPERSON:

-Work with and oversee the Fundraising Committee

-Work on any additional fundraising opportunities

HOLIDAY CHAIRPERSON:
