





Pop Tabs



Collecting pop tabs are a great way for children, schools, and other large groups to get involved in fundraising for the House. The funds generated from recycling these aluminum gems help offset the House's expenses. Tabs can be dropped off in the bin outside the House any day.



Tips and Tricks for Pop Tab Collection

-  If its painted, its probably plastic. Pop tabs that are a color other than silver are typically coated in plastic and will often be rejected by the metal recycler.
-  Metals that are not aluminum can contaminate our pop tab collections. Since aluminum is not magnetic, you can run a magnet over your collection to check your tabs.
-  Please use containers that are easy to open such as cardboard boxes and sturdy plastic bags. Please do not use containers that are difficult to get the pop tabs out of such as water cooler jugs or plastic milk jugs.
-  If it's convenient, you can also take your personal pop tab collection to a local metal recycler and have the proceeds donated to the House instead.

Frequently Asked Questions

Why do you only collect the tab?

A pop tab is made completely of aluminum, but a can is typically made of a combination of metals.

How much are the pop tabs worth?

It take about 1,200 pop tabs to equal one pound. One pound of tabs is worth about \$0.45.

Can I mail my my pop tabs to you?

While we will accept any pop tabs shipped to the House, it is often more cost effective to drop them off at the House or take them to a local metal recycler and donate the proceeds.
